QUALIFYING/ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS, RULES and CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Qualifying Requirements: Horse/pony is required to have attended two official show fixtures run by a SHC WA affiliate club within the qualifying period.

Qualifying Period: 10 May 2008 to 8 May 2009.

Eligibility Requirements: The onus is on the owner / exhibitor / representative to make sure that their horse / pony is eligible to compete in this event.

1. The horse must be registered with the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. National Saddle Horse Register prior to close of entries on 8 May 2009.
2. The rider and owner / lessee must be a financial member of Show Horse Council WA Inc. prior to the close of entries and on the day of competition.
3. The horse / pony must not have competed under saddle in any discipline (racing excepted), either official or unofficial prior to the commencement of the qualifying period, that is 10 May 2008.

Rules and Conditions of Entry:

In addition to the rules outlined below all competitors should take note of the SHC Australasia Inc. General Competition Rules, which will apply, unless precluded by rules or conditions of entry specific to this show, the West Coast Saddlery Debutante 2009.

1. The horse/pony may only be ridden in a snaffle.
2. **All riders** regardless of age are required to wear an approved safety helmet.
3. Horses/Ponies can only compete in either Show Hunter or Show Horse Classes.
4. Horses/Ponies current Show Horse Council WA height certificate must be attached to the entry form (copy only).
5. Horse registration papers with the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. National Saddle Horse register must be attached to the entry form (copy only).
6. Show Horse Council of WA Inc. membership number for owner/exhibitor/representative and rider must be included on entry form – entry is for members only.
7. Random Swabbing may take place.
8. Rider any age on ponies.
9. This Show is run with two rings, please check the schedule of classes and notify the Ground Jury of any clashes. While every effort will be made to accommodate a conflict, to avoid delays in the competition a ring will not be held up for an extended period.
10. Alcohol is prohibited – the consumption or possession of alcohol may result in disciplinary action and/or disqualification. Riders are not to be under the influence of alcohol during the competition.
11. Entry and Competition in the Show is voluntary. The Exhibitors and Competitors enter and compete entirely at their own risk. By Entry it is the Absolute Liability of all participants to agree to be bound by the decisions of the Ground Jury and/or Show Horse Council of WA Inc. Committee and compete in accordance with all Rules applicable to the Competition.
12. The SHC WA Inc. reserves the right to interpret all rules where any dispute arises.

PLEASE NOTE: NO DOGS are allowed on Grounds and **ALCOHOL IS NOT PERMITTED** on the Grounds
